



Common Ground 2022 - an introduction

What is it?

Common Ground 2022 is a fabulous international camp of ideas, education and games for social change. It is organised by Woodcraft Folk, and supported by the International Falcon Movement – Socialist Education International (IFM-SEI). The camp will take place at the **Kelmarsh Gardens, Northamptonshire, UK** from **29 July – 8 August 2022**.

Why take part?

Common Ground 2022 is the first **international camp in the UK since 2011**. It will bring together thousands of children and young people from across the world for **ten days of camping, cooperation, and friendship**.

The theme of the camp is **International Friendship and Solidarity**. There is an extensive programme of activities for all ages, including under 5's. Participants will learn about different topics - Anti-Racism and Anti-Fascism, Bushcraft, Arts, Media, Environment and Human Rights in interactive workshops. In the evenings, there is live music and entertainment in a family-friendly setting.

How much?

The camp costs £215 per person (or £135 for 5 days), including camp activities and all meals. The best way to reduce the cost for every camper, is to fundraise as a local group. Fundraising support is available from the Common Ground team.

Is it safe and well organised?

A lot of the programme is youth-led. We also have a designated staff team that looks after the health and safety, safeguarding, food logistics and technical set-up of the camp. This is to ensure people of all ages and abilities can enjoy the camp in an inclusive and safe way.
